Thanks to you and other supporters, ISN is helping more homeless and at-risk individuals and families than ever. People like Theresa J., ISN Emergency Shelter Program client.

Theresa was employed as a food server until a year ago, when COVID shut down both of the restaurants she worked at part-time. At first, COVID relief benefits helped her stay housed. As the summer progressed, both restaurants re-opened then closed again and Maria worked whenever possible.

Fearful for her own failing health, the women from whom Theresa rented a room decided that it wasn't safe for her to stay in her home any longer. By the end of September, Theresa was homeless. Thankfully, she was referred to ISN's Emergency Shelter Program by 2.1.1SanDiego and was quickly moved into a safe motel room. While she waited for restaurants to re-open, Theresa applied for other jobs and was offered a job at a nearby grocery store. Within another few weeks, she found a rental situation and moved into a room with a private entrance. She has stayed in touch with case management and is thrilled that San Diego is finally out of the purple tier and what that can mean for her employment situation.

ISN is providing services to more than 400 individuals in need, including families who are homeless due to domestic violence, households who are just newly housed and those who are at-risk of losing their housing. Your gift allows them to overcome the obstacles that threaten their housing and stay safe at home.

Thank you for being an important part of this challenging work. With your support we will continue to provide shelter, meals and more to individuals and families who are without permanent housing or at-risk of losing it.
